

Checklist for Grade 10s registering for Grade 11

1. Students only need one English class this year, English LA 20. Other English classes like Media Studies or Creative Writing are electives.
2. Students must have at least one math, either Math 20 or 21 (modified) to graduate. Math 30A and 30B may be chosen as electives and we recommend they take these courses in grade 11.
3. Students must have one class of: History 20, Native Studies 20 or 30; Psychology 20 or 30, Geography 30 or Law 30. For all of these 30 level classes the 20 level is not a prerequisite for the 30 level course. History 10 is the prerequisite.
4. Students need one Science course: Biology 20, Chemistry 20, Computer Science 20, Physics 20, or Science 21. Science 21 is modified science and should be selected based on the recommendation of their Science 10 teacher.
5. Grade 11 students should register for a minimum of 9 courses.
6. Choir 20 will only be taught before school from 8-8:50am Monday, Wednesday, and Friday all year long and is worth 1 credit.
7. Students choosing an on-line course must meet with a counsellor and complete an application form. This form requires both a parent and counsellor's signature. An on line course would be one of the 9 courses listed.
8. Students may only choose Resource Room with the recommendation and consultation with their current resource room teacher or grade 10 counsellor.
9. All regular level compulsory subjects for grade 11 will end in '20', for example 'History 20'. Modified courses will end in '11', for example modified history would be History 21. Modified courses should only be selected in consultation with current subject teacher and counsellor.
10. READ 20 is a developmental reading course and can only be selected with consultation with your current English teacher or counsellor.
11. Students should register in any compulsory courses that the students failed first semester.
12. Students need to have two Arts Education or Practical & Applied Arts at the 10, 20, or 30 level before they graduate.
