

Checklist for Grade 9s registering for Grade 10

1. Students must have two English courses, ELA10 and ELB10. Students do not need to take the “A” before the “B”.
2. Students must have one Science, one History, & one Wellness (PE). When students are choosing their Wellness course on line, females will chose WLF 10 and males will choose WLM 10.
3. Students will take Foundations of Math and Precalculus 10 and Workplace and Apprenticeship Math 10. Math 11 is modified math and would only be selected with the consultation with the Math 9 teacher and grade 9 counsellor.
4. The integrated English/History 10 course involves ELB10. It is one teacher teaching both courses and is worth 2 credits. When selecting this program on line students will choose both courses separately (ELB10-G, and HIS10-G)
5. “Earthkeepers” is an integrated program of English A10, Science 10, Wellness 10, Apprenticeship Math 10, and Practical and Applied Arts Survey 10 consisting of Horticulture, Foods, and Design Studies. When choosing these courses on-line students will select ELA10-G, SCI10-G, WLL10-G, WA10-G, PAA10-G.
6. All regular level compulsory subjects for grade 10 will end in ‘10’, for example ‘Science 10’. Modified courses will end in ‘11’, for example modified science would be Science 11. Modified courses should only be selected in consultation with current subject teacher and grade 9 counsellor.
7. Students registering in Resource must have the permission of their current Resource Room Teacher and/or grade 9 counsellor.
8. Choir will be taught before school from 8-8:50am Monday, Wednesday, and Friday all year long, and is worth 1 credit.
9. Grade 10 students should have 10 courses listed, as they do not get spares. Choir may be the 10 course with special permission by the counsellor.
10. Students choosing an on-line course must meet with a counsellor and complete an application form. This form requires both a parent and counsellor’s signature. An on-line course would be one of the 10 courses listed.
11. Students should register in any grade 9 compulsory courses that the student has failed first semester.
12. Grade 10 students are generally allowed to have 3 electives; Choir could be an additional elective.
13. Students need to have two Arts Education or Practical & Applied Arts before they graduate. It is good practice to fulfill these requirements in grade 10.
14. Language Arts Study 10/20 is a developmental reading course and can only be selected with consultation with your current English teacher and/or counsellor.
