

## **LEVELS OF DIFFICULTY**

Regular Level courses are designed for students whose achievement and rate of learning in the subject are average. Such courses require the students to be able to work on their own after the teacher has helped them to develop basic understanding. The pace of instruction is intended to ensure mastery by the students.

Enriched Level courses are designed for students whose achievement and rate of learning in the subject are above average. Strategies may include:

- Acceleration of the pace of instruction
- Emphasis on higher order thinking skills
- Emphasis on independent learning & research

Course levels are determined separately for each subject. For example, it is possible for a given student to be in enriched English and regular math. Students should select levels which provide them with the opportunity and stimulation to learn and to develop as unique people.

\* Students will need permission of current instructor to enter Enriched programming.

Modified Level courses are designed for students whose achievement and rate of learning in the subject level are below grade average. These courses concentrate upon content that can be applied directly to everyday life. Aden Bowman Collegiate offers these courses primarily in the course areas of English, Mathematics, and Science and Social Sciences.

Each student is individually timetabled. We recommend grade 10,11 and 12 students carry a minimum of 9 courses. Final placement in levels is a school decision.
